Q. Do you have any crime statistics for Union County?

A. Yes, we gathered the following statistics on crime in Union County from the website, www.georgiastats.uga.edu.

Just to put this in perspective, here are the 2011 stats for Fulton County.

*Violent crimes are murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault

Q. Do you have any information on traffic crashes in Union County and how many are alcohol related?

A. The most recent data we could find (Georgia County Guide) is from 2009 and 2010:

In 2009 there were 2 fatalities in crashes with 1 involving an alcohol impaired driver.

In 2010 there were 4 fatalities in crashes with 0 being due to alcohol impaired driver.

Q. What are some statistics on voting in Union County?

When we ranked the % of voter turnout for all Georgia counties in the general election for 2012, we were amazed and pleased to see that **Union County ranked #1 at 85.8% voter turnout**. The lowest ranked county was Chattahoochee at 36.3%.

Q. What are some other interesting statistics on Union County?

A. Here are some miscellaneous stats:

- Deaths, major cardiovascular diseases, 2010 94
- Deaths, cancer, 2010 60
- Deaths, Respiratory system, 2010 28

Q. Here are some other interesting statistics on birth and death in Union County.

A. These are statistics for the year 2010:

- Total teen pregnancies 27
- Births to unwed mothers 52
- Total county deaths 283
- Total homicides 1
- Total suicides 1

Q. How many babies are born in Union County?

A. For the years 1998-2007 there were a total of 216 live births in Union County:

6.1 % were born to mothers age 15-17
10.2% to mothers 18-19
34.3 % to mothers age 20-24
26.9% to mothers 25-29
14.8% to mothers 30-34
7.9% to mothers 35-39
3.2% to mothers 40+

Q. How many farms are in Union County?

A. In Union County in the year 1945, according to the website, www.georgiastats.uga.edu, there were 1,292 farms. As you can see the number of farms steadily declined in the years following:
