Thus it is not suitable for use on curved roofs or complex roofing shapes.

Corrugated Roofing:

Corrugated roofing is very common, found almost everywhere in the world, may it be roof of a shed or a barn. It is identified as a symmetrical pattern of ridges and grooves, shaped on a thin sheet. This type of roofing is generally made of steel, polycarbonate or asphalt-fiberglass materials, and is often used for covering agricultural and commercial buildings. It can be used for porches or sheds in a house, but as the main house roofing material, since it is not very strong and aesthetic.

Slate Roofing:

Slate is a form of a stone, and this type of roofing can be expensive owing to the strength and durability of slate. Moreover, it is not easy to install and requires expert craftsmanship. The material comes from slate deposits in Vermont and Pennsylvania.
