The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Paris at 4:30 pm.

The Commissioner adopted an Emergency Moratorium on applications, processing, and consideration for Multi-Family Unit Developments in Union County for a period of 120 days. A Multi-Family Unit Development is defined as more than one residential dwelling unit per structure, so this would include townhouses, apartment complexes or similar structures. Commissioner Paris stated that the County has found that there is a need to address standards relating to the development of Multi-Family Units and create standards relating to the development of these types of properties located within the County.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 4:43.
