

Called Meeting
December 13, 2021 5:30pm

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Lamar Paris at 5:31 pm. He stated that the purpose of this Called Meeting was to adopt the 2022 Budget.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Bill Walker and the Invocation was given by Mitch Griggs.

Commissioner Paris said that since the Public Hearing one individual, Nick Nichols, had requested additional information and he had that information available if it was needed. No other questions or comments had been made to the Commissioner's Office regarding the Budget.

The Commissioner then asked if there were any questions from those in attendance and there were none.

Commissioner Paris approved Resolution R-2021-15 to adopt the 2022 Budget in the amount of \$22,878,191. Union County held a Public Hearing on December 2, 2021, at 5:30pm to discuss and answer any questions regarding the proposed budget. Attendees were provided a copy of the proposed budget attached to the agenda. The Commissioner went on to say that he was proud of staff, elected officials, and all county employees who work so hard to keep the county's operation costs under control and to maximize revenue. He then thanked Laura Driskell, Union County Finance Director, for her hard work on the budget this year. He also thanked Larry Garrett, County Manager and Pam Hawkins, Purchasing Agent, for their hard work on the budget as well.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 5:36 pm.
